

### Outline and Suggested Order of Videos

(All videos, prayers, and crafts can be found on "Day 3" of Summer Faith Adventure)

- 1. Watch the "Welcome" video.
- **2.** Click the audio link to pray with us a selected decade of the Rosary. Listen carefully to the introduction and the Scripture passages because they will help you understand the day's lessons better. Consider the following:
  - Why do you think Jesus instituted both the priesthood and the Eucharist at the same time?
  - Why do you think Jesus did not invite His Mother to the Last Supper?
     Do you think it had to do with what He instituted there?
  - What do you think a priest's greatest service to his parish is?
- **3.** Watch the "King David and King Solomon" video and consider the following questions:
  - Why do you think God was pleased with what Solomon asked to receive (wisdom)? Should we also pray for gifts that serve other people?
  - BONUS: Why do we genuflect to the tabernacle in a Catholic Church? (Hint: Who is in the tabernacle?)
  - •How should we act in church because of Whom we know is in the tabernacle?
- 4. Watch the "Craft" video and then make the craft.
- 5. Do the coloring and activity pages.
- **6.** Watch the "Game" video and play the game. You're spiritually safe close to the bishops and the Pope.
- **7.** Watch the "Confession" video. Consider these questions:
  - Jesus gave His Apostles the power to forgive sins when He breathed on them. How is this power passed on to the bishops and priests today?
  - Why should we want to go to Confession?
  - What happens to your sins after the priest hears your confession? What does God do with your sins after He hears your confession?



### Outline and Suggested Order of Videos

(All videos, prayers, and crafts can be found on "Day 3" of Summer Faith Adventure)

- **8.** Watch the "Eucharist" video and consider the following:
  - Since when God says something—it happens, when Jesus said, "This is My Body," while holding a piece of bread, what happened?
  - Why is it so important that someone is in a state of grace when they receive Communion?
  - If you stood before God in Heaven, what would you do? How would you act?
- **9.** Have older children dig deeper by reading these Bible verses to identify some of the key lessons noted:
  - Matthew 9:2-8 (Son of Man has authority to forgive sins)
  - John 20:19-23 (Jesus gives power to forgive and not forgive sins)
  - 2 Corinthians 5:17-20 (given us the ministry of reconciliation)
  - James 5:13-16 (presbyters [priests] forgive sin)
  - Matthew 18:18 (whatever Apostles bind and loose on earth, so it is in Heaven)
  - 1 John 5:16 (There is sin that is not deadly. There are mortal—deadly sins—and "not deadly" sins—venial sins.)
  - John Chapter 6 (the "Bread of Life" discourses in which Jesus promises to give the Eucharist)
  - 1 Corinthians 10:16 (Mass is a participation in Christ's Body and Blood)
  - Exodus 12:8, 46 (the Paschal, or Passover, lamb had to be eaten to save you from death)
  - John 1:29 (Jesus is called the "Lamb of God." In the Old Testament, you had to eat the lamb of sacrifice.)
  - 1 Corinthians 5:7 (Jesus is called the "paschal lamb who has been sacrificed.")
- 10. Watch the snack video and make the snack
- **11.** Pray the Angelus.

# Activities

### Day 3 Craft: Prayer Books

### Supplies:

Colorful construction paper
Prayers (see below)
Pictures (see below)
Scissors
Glue
Stapler or hole punch and string, yarn, or ribbon

# Activites

### Day 3 Snack: Soft Pretzels

4-5 cups flour

21/4 tsp yeast In large bowl, combine water and yeast. Add sugar and salt.

1 ½ cup warm water Add flour until you have stiff, pliable dough.

1 tsp salt

1 tbsp sugar Place on floured surface and knead 5 to 8 minutes.

Pretzel salt or cinnamon Then take a ball of dough and roll onto a long, thin string.

Shape the string into a pretzel shape.

Brush with one beaten egg and sprinkle with salt or cinna-

mon.

Bake at 425 degrees for 5 minutes or until golden brown.

### Day 3 Game: Protect the Priest

Protest the Priest is like dodge ball so you'll need several balls for this game. The more people you have, the more balls you need. Split everyone into two teams and choose one person on each team to be the "priest". Make two sides and choose something to separate then.

The point of the game is to hit people on the other team with your balls. If some gets hit by a ball, he has to sit down and the priest has to come and "heal" him by tagging him. Only the priest can heal people and he can't heal himself so if he gets hit, no one on the team can get healed. So it is very important to protect the priest so you can win.



### Welcome to the third day of Holy Heroes Summer Faith Adventure: The New Kingdom of David!

**Today, we are going to talk about the priesthood** because in the Church the priests are under the authority of the Pope and bishops.

**Today, we will pray the Fifth Luminous Mystery, which is about the Last Supper.** At the Last Supper, Jesus instituted the priesthood and the Eucharist.

We will see another video about King David and learn about who built the Temple and the first tabernacle. We will also learn how Jesus promises us a long life, just like the long life He promised Solomon, the son of King David, and how we, too, can receive this "long life."

**Two other videos are about two sacraments** that only priests (and bishops, since they are priests, too) can give: **Confession and the Eucharist**.

**The craft today is a Prayer Book** that you can make yourself using the pictures that are bound into this book, ready for you to cut out and enjoy! Learn your prayers and remember to pray for one another.

"This is My Body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of Me." (Luke 22:15,19)




"It is not man that causes the things offered to become the Body and Blood of Christ, but He Who was crucified for us, Christ Himself.

The priest, in the role of Christ [in persona Christi], pronounces these words, but their power and grace are God's.

'This is My Body,' he says. This word transforms the things offered.

(St. John Chrysostom, late 4th century, quoted in Catechism of the Catholic Church 1375)

Jesus said to [His disciples] again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent Me, so I send you." And when He had said this, He breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." (John 20:21-23)




"God, the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of His Son, has reconciled the world to Himself and sent the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God give you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

### Across


- Jesus died on "Good \_\_\_\_\_." (Hint: a day of the week.)
