

#### Outline and Suggested Order of Videos

(All videos, prayers, and crafts can be found on "Day 4" of Summer Faith Adventure)

- 1. Watch the "Welcome" video.
- **2.** Click the audio link to pray with us a selected decade of the Rosary. Listen carefully to the introduction and the Scripture passages because they will help you understand the day's lessons better. Consider the following:
  - Why do you think Jesus did His first public miracle at a wedding?
  - What happens at a wedding?
  - What does Mary do? What is Jesus' response to His mother? What is your response to your mother when she tells you that there is something you could do to help someone?
- **3.** Watch the "Kingdom of David" video and consider the following questions:
  - How did David become king, and how did Solomon and all the others after David become king?
  - Why does Jesus pick everyone to be part of a family? Why does He pick people to be in one family instead of in another?
  - What are some ways we can help our parents? What are ways we can sacrifice for them? How can we help them get to Heaven? Same questions for our siblings.
  - What are little sacrifices we can do to practice for bigger sacrifices?
- 4. Watch the "Craft" video and then make the craft.
- 5. Do the coloring and activity pages.
- 6. Watch the "Game" video and play the game.



#### Outline and Suggested Order of Videos

(All videos, prayers, and crafts can be found on "Day 4" of Summer Faith Adventure)

- **7.** Watch the "Matrimony" video. Consider these questions:
  - Why was marriage the first human relationship that God made at the beginning of the world?
  - Why does God give us the special help of grace given in the sacrament of marriage?
  - Why do you think that a priest or deacon just witnesses a marriage, but the man and woman are the ones who actually "do the marrying"?
- **8.** Have older children dig deeper by reading these Bible verses to identify some of the key lessons noted:
  - Matthew 19:5-6 (leave father and mother; two become one flesh)
  - Mark 5:32-33 (what God has joined together, no man can separate)
  - Ephesians 5:22-32 (union of man and wife image of Christ and Church, i.e. Christ never divorces His Church)
  - Hebrews 13:4 (let marriage be honored among all)
  - Genesis 2:18-24 (original marriage)
- 9. Watch the snack video and make the snack.
- 10. Pray the Angelus.

#### Supplies:

Construction paper Markers Tape

## Activities

#### Day 4 Snack: Crispy Treats

1/4 cup butter Melt marshmallows and butter in microwave or on stove top.

5 ½ cups marshmallows Once they are melted, mix in crispy rice and vanilla.

½ tsp vanilla

 $5 \frac{1}{2}$  cups crisp rice cereal Mix until all the cereal is sticky. Pour into greased pan and

press down. You might need to grease you hands.

Put in fridge till hard.

#### Day 4 Game: The Family Teamwork Game

Get a few boards, paper plates, or anything else you can stand on. The fewer objects you use, the harder it will be. Choose a place to start and a place you want to finish.

Have everyone stand on an object. Try to cram as many people on as you can. After everyone is on, the person at the end of the line passes the object to the person in the front who in turn places it on the ground. Then, everyone moves on to the new object on the ground. This is repeated until you move to where you want.

If someone falls off, everyone has to go back to the beginning and start again. This game teaches teamwork, everyone needs to work together to get to the end.

# Day 4

#### Welcome to the fourth day of Holy Heroes Summer Faith Adventure: The New Kingdom of David!

For the last three days, we have talked about the establishment of the Catholic Church and who has authority in the Church. **So, today we are going to talk about the family.** Did you know that each family is called a "domestic church"? Each family is meant to live as a little church. That means that God put every person into your family on purpose, so that you can help each other get to Heaven. So, we are all in our families to serve and pray for each other.

**Today, we will pray the Second Luminous Mystery, the Wedding Feast at Cana,** because every marriage is the beginning of a family.

The Kingdom of David video is about how Jesus is the descendent of King David and how Jesus picked His mother, Mary, and His father on earth, Joseph. Jesus picked your parents, too, and He tells you to honor them in the Fourth Commandment, just like He honored His parents.

The video on the sacrament is about the sacrament of Marriage because every marriage is the beginning of a family.

Our craft is making a family tree so that we know who is in our family and so we remember all the people we need to pray for—even those who have died. The template is in this book, and the instructions are in the daily video of *Summer Faith Adventure*.




